The NewView Oklahoma Low Vision Clinic in Oklahoma City and Low Vision Center in Tulsa offer hope and independence to clients with low vision or blindness. We serve clients from across the state and accept referrals from ophthalmologists and optometrists.

Proceeds from our manufacturing cover a percentage of our total operating expenses. We rely on grants, and donations from individuals and corporate citizens for the remainder.

Our headquarters and manufacturing facilities are located in downtown Oklahoma City at 501 N. Douglas Ave. Our 156,000-square-foot facility was formerly a working brewery for the Progress Lone Star Brewing companies. Lone Star generously sold the building to us in 1973, for one dollar.
